Step 1: Cast On

- CO 60 sts using your chosen knitting needles.

Step 2: Ribbed Pattern

- **Row 1:** K2, P2, repeat across the row.
- **Row 2:** P2, K2, repeat across the row.

- Repeat rows 1 and 2 until the hat measures approximately 4 inches from the cast-on edge.

Step 3: Shaping the Crown

- **Decrease Row:** K2tog, P2tog, repeat across the row. (50 sts)
- **Next Row:** K1, P1, repeat across the row.
- **Repeat the last two rows:** until 10 sts remain.

Step 4: Gather the Crown

- Cut the yarn, leaving a 6-inch tail.
- Thread the tail through the remaining sts and pull tight to gather the crown.
- Sew the gathered crown closed using the yarn needle.

Step 5: Brim

- Pick up 60 sts evenly around the circumference of the hat.
- Join the round and work in stockinette stitch (knit every round) for 1-1.5 inches.

Step 6: Bind Off

- BO all sts loosely.

Finishing

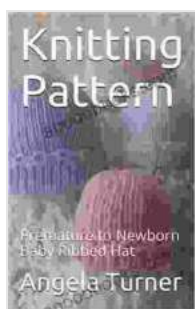
- Weave in any loose ends.

- Steam or block the hat for a professional-looking finish.

Tips

- For a cozier fit, choose a yarn with soft and insulating properties, such as merino wool or alpaca.
- For a more snug fit, use smaller needles or a thicker yarn.
- To customize the hat, you can add a pompom or tassel to the top.
- Embroider the baby's name or a special message on the brim for a personalized touch.

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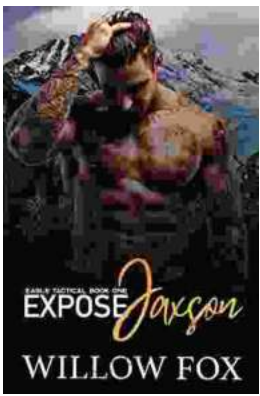
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
